FISCAL/MANDATES IMPACT: None

DISCUSSION:

The average daily portfolio balance for the month of July amounted to \$ 1.7 billion. The portfolio yield for the month of July was .66 %. The weighted average days to maturity decreased 28 days to 309 days. The total net monthly earnings were \$ 935 thousand. The portfolio has been structured to satisfy the anticipated cash flow needs of the participants. The investment practices and portfolio holdings are in compliance with the investment policy.

The portfolio has been managed with the stated objectives of safety, liquidity and earning a competitive rate of return, outlined in the Statement of Investment Policy. In striving to maintain the primary objective, safety of principal, the County portfolio has received a rating of AAAf by Standard & Poor's, the highest possible ranking given by the agency. Regarding the secondary objective, maintaining sufficient liquidity to meet cash flow needs, the portfolio is rated S1+, also the highest ranking given by S&P. In light of the first two objectives the portfolio has on balance outperformed its benchmarks, satisfying the final objective, that of earning a competitive rate of return.

High borrowing costs for many of Europe's weakest economies and a surprise announcement by the European Central Bank (ECB) to increase the purchase of those governments bonds caused significant swings in U. S. equity and bond markets during the month. While overall interest rates remain at historic lows in the U. S. we did see large movement in longer term rates as rates were initially driven down by a flight out of European government debt as borrowing costs for Spain and Italy spiked. The yield on Spanish government 2 year bonds rose to over 7% prompting fear that the country would need some form of bailout. This caused U. S. government debt to rise in value

and the corresponding yields to fall. The rise in borrowing costs for Spain caused the ECB to announce that it would be willing to purchase more government debt to help ease the strain on these ailing governments. This had the effect in the U. S. of reversing some of the decline in domestic bond yields.

Aside from the volatility contributed by Europe, interest rates remain low across the yield curve as economic activity continued at a very modest pace. In mid July the Federal Reserve released its so called Beige Book, a region by region report of overall economic activity in the U. S. In the report the Fed provided these observations:

- Overall economic activity continued to expand at a modest to moderate pace
- Retail sales increased slightly
- Tourism activity remained strong
- Housing markets were largely positive as sales and construction levels increased and home inventories declined
- Commercial real estate leasing and construction continued to improve
- Manufacturing activity continued to expand slowly, however there were reports of a deceleration in new orders
- Demand for nonfinancial services remained generally stable
- Loan demand particularly that related to real estate grew modestly
- Agricultural production and pricing were mixed with the drought affecting production in some areas

Other economic data released during the month mirrored these views. The unemployment rate remained unchanged at 8.2% while the economy created only 80,000 new jobs. Consumer confidence reports were higher as were personal income, orders for durable goods, industrial production, construction spending and factory orders. However, home sales moved lower and the initial look at the Gross Domestic Product, the broadest measure of domestic economic activity, for the second quarter showed annualized growth at a mere 1.5%.

As noted earlier interest rates moved significantly during the month but the net effect was very small as rates were nearly unchanged at the end of the month. Short-term rates were unchanged to down 3 basis points while longer-term rates were down about 5 basis points.

Given the current interest rate environment we anticipate the County's yield to drop modestly. Further, we continue to seek investment opportunities in order to optimize earnings (U. S. Treasury Market graph attached).

Attached is a listing of market values provided by our custodian, Wells Fargo Bank, for all investments for the month ending July 31, 2012. GASB Statement no. 31 states that variances between the cost of investments and the fair value of investments shall not be considered budgetary resources or uses of resources unless the value of investments is permanently impaired because of decreased issuer creditworthiness or it is determined that the Treasurer be unable to hold investments to maturity.





PORTFOLIO AVERAGE MONTHLY BALANCE




AVERAGE MATURITY




